Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to Term 4.

I trust everyone had an enjoyable break and some quality family time. Term 4 is a very busy time as we very quickly head to the end of the year. Please read this carefully for all the important dates relevant to you and your children.

Principal and Honour awards: It is fabulous to see these come through across the year and those very successful students who achieve the Principal's medallion. To everyone well done! Please note that there are fewer assemblies this term, so to be presented they need to be into the front office at least 1 week prior to each assembly. The last assembly for presentation is Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> November so certificates need to be at the office by the 15<sup>th</sup> November. Any that come in later than that will be presented at the morning assembly and only for students in Year 6 or leaving us at the end of the year. The rest will be presented next year.

This term we will be trialling a new transition to High school program across weeks 6-7. Across these two weeks (except Wednesdays) we will be operating a High School timetable for students in grades 5 and 6 and this will be supported by a number of high school teachers from Kingswood High School. On these days, students will be given a time table with classes/ subjects to move to and participate in. The subjects will be a blend of high school and primary school content and they will be in different rooms with different teachers across the two weeks. We are hoping for our students to meet and make connections with high school teachers, to share knowledge and understandings and get a sense about what high school will look like for them. The exceptions are Wednesdays: in Week 6 it is the Multicultural Day and in Week 7 it is the Celebration of Learning Assembly.

This term my Executive and I start to plan the classes and structure for the new school year. If your family is leaving our school at the end of the year please let us know as soon as possible, similarly if you are seeking or know of anyone seeking enrolment please also contact the school ASAP.

Please be advised that I will be taking leave from Monday 2nd December for the remainder of the school year. For these three weeks Mrs Puckeridge will be the relieving Principal. I am taking leave to support my daughter who needs to travel to access additional research for her Master's degree. It's a real privilege and thrill, as she is being given research access to the closed areas of the British Museum, Oxford University library and the Louve in Paris. Of course some holiday fun will be included!
